The Chinese Readers Series

- ◆ 1 set of 50 illustrated story books based on linguistic theories
- ◆ Focusing on 1 Chinese Grammatical Structure in each story

Chinese Radical Learning Papercraft



- ◆ Papercrafts for enhancing children's knowledge of Chinese characters structures and the relevant meaning of characters sharing same radicals
- ◆ 21 radicals with 100 Chinese characters
- ◆ 5 different types of papercrafts
- ◆ Illustration and associated vocabulary for each character to enhance learning
- ◆ Information sheet on the historical changes of Chinese Radicals

Chinese Grammar Online Game

- ◆ Including a number of common Chinese grammatical categories encountered by students
- ◆ Questions designed to tackle common errors committed by students
- ◆ 5 non-oral and non-written tasks
- ◆ Offering teachers the information on students' performance for follow up actions



Online Library System

- ◆ Aiming at providing a self-learning platform for teachers and students in learning Hong Kong Sign Language
- ◆ Providing sign language support in reading and learning
- ◆ Divided into 4 main sections: "Baby Signing", "Chinese Readers Series", "English Books" and "I Can Read"
- ◆ The "Baby Signing" section is opened for public viewing with currently 3092 video clips online.
